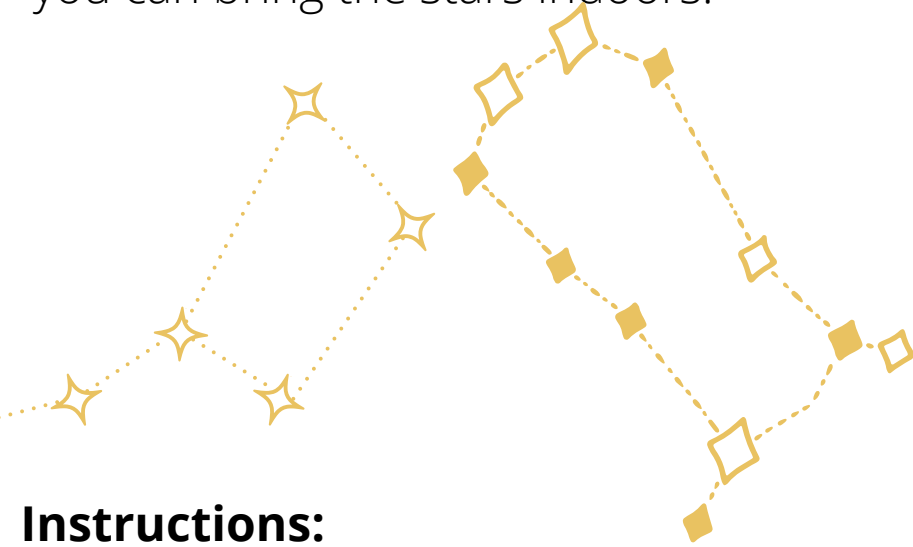


Make a Constellation Torch

In some places -- especially those with lots of light pollution -- seeing the stars at night can be quite difficult. Make this constellation torch so you can bring the stars indoors!



You Will Need:

- Card or thick paper
- Pen or pencil
- Torch
- Scissors

Instructions:

- Trace around the lens of your torch on your card or paper to make a circle. Repeat to make more constellations and cut out the circles.
- Choose your first constellation (there are suggestions here: www.dkfindout.com/uk/space/constellations/). Trace where the stars are in the constellation onto your circle. You may choose to connect them, but you will not see the lines when you turn your torch on.
- With your pen or pencil, CAREFULLY poke a hole at each point where there is a star on your circle. Try to make them as clean and open as you can so that the light will shine through.
- Place your card on the end of your torch. Turn the lights off, and turn your torch on. Instant constellations!
