



Explore a Virtual Laboratory

Explore the labs at University of Dundee's Life Sciences on Google Streetview to tour them from the comfort and safety of your own home.

What do I need?

- A device with access to the internet
- A sheet of paper
- Felt tip pens or pencils

What to do

1. On your computer, tablet, phone or any other device which can use Google maps, go to <https://www.google.com/maps>
2. Enter our postcode, DD1 5AA
3. Click the yellow street view icon - often found in the lower right corner of your screen.
4. You should then see a lot of the blue circles over our building. Click on any of them and you'll be transported into our labs.

5. Once you're in there, there's lots to see. Things to watch out for include:
- Our chemistry labs, which are the eastern/right end of the building. This is where we make new molecules which we hope will become medicines, one day.
 - Our biology labs, in the upper left of the dots. In the labs we grow disease-causing bugs, experiment on them, and see what the medicines do to their cells - and ours.
 - On the lower right of your screen, you might see a column of numbers. 1-4 will take you between different floors, while 5 and 6 will quickly zip you between parts of the building.
 - The lower left dots take you to our big, open central space and perhaps the most important thing of all - our coffee shop!
