



## Snow Goggles

**Make your own pair of Captain Scott's snow goggles**

### **What you will need:**

Cardboard  
Pencil  
Sharp scissors (ask an adult use these for you)  
String or ribbon  
Sellotape

### **What you will do:**

Draw a large hourglass shape on the cardboard (to make sure you get the size right for your goggles it could help to compare with a pair of your sunglasses if you have them).

Ask an adult to cut out the shape you have drawn using the sharp scissors. Once cut out mark a large plus sign where your eyes would look through and ask the adult to cut along the lines to create the narrow eye slits. You can look at the 3D scan of Captain Scott's goggles to help make sure you get this part looking right.

Cut a piece of string or ribbon to the right size to go around the back of your head and use the sellotape to attach it to your goggles. You might want to ask for help while you adjust the string to make sure it fits you just right.

Now explore your home or garden wearing your goggles – it will be difficult to see with only the small slits to look through so be careful as you explore.
